

## **Cisco Lab Assistant**

There are currently up to 6 positions available for Cisco Lab assistants for both the Summer and Fall semesters. There are several criteria to be eligible for one of these positions:

Must be eligible for Federal College Work Study

Must be currently enrolled in Cisco courses or have already gone through Cisco courses

Must be able on occasion to lift between 50 and 75 pound items with help.

These positions will have a variety of duties and responsibilities. The students that fill these positions will assist in building the new CCNP lab at the technology center. This means putting together desks, making cables, running cables, mounting equipment, testing equipment, etc. The students will also be tasked on occasion with setting up pre-designed labs for classroom use. The students will be tasked with maintaining the routers and switches by keeping them clean, and possibly loading new IOS images when they become available. The students will be tasked with monitoring the labs for student accessibility to the labs to work on their assignments. This means the students must have a working knowledge of Cisco or at least where to find information in order to provide assistance to those students using the lab should they require it. Students will be tasked with miscellaneous paper work and research projects in order to assist the program in expanding. Other tasks may be assigned on an as needed basis.

The exact number of hours scheduled will be determined on the amount of eligibility the individual student has for student work study. These positions will be supervised and overseen by the Cisco Project Coordinator.
