COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

PURPOSE

The purpose of this articulation agreement is to assist students at various levels of higher education to achieve their educational goals in an efficient and timely way. The specific objectives of the collaborative agreement are to (1) better inform students of their many options as they consider attending both institutions, (2) enhance the process by which students are admitted into and transfer between the two institutions, (3) achieve increased effectiveness and student service by considering joint programs and services offered at both institutions that benefit the shared student body, and (4) undertake shared leadership initiatives to better serve the economic and other community development needs of the service region.

ELEMENTS OF THE AGREEMENT

SUGGESTED CURRICULUM OUTLINE AND ADVISING GUIDE FOR STUDENTS PURSUING ADN IN NURSING FROM BLUE RIDGE CTC AND TRANSFERRING TO SHENANDOAH UNIVERSITY'S SCHOOL OF NURSING:

- A. Blue Ridge Community & Technical College graduates are exempt from General Education requirements since students are entering Shenandoah University with an Associate of Science in Nursing
- B. Per Shenandoah University policy, twenty-four of the last 30 credit hours required in a baccalaureate degree program must be earned at Shenandoah University. Credits earned at institutions with specific program articulation agreements with Shenandoah University will be considered as Shenandoah University credits for this requirement.

Any deficiency in the number of credits outside the prerequisite requirements can be made up with elective credits to equal 121 credits for the baccalaureate degree.

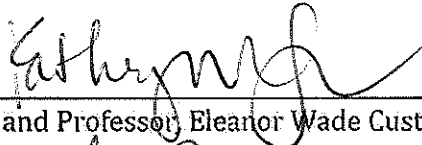

A. COMMUNICATION AND TERMS OF AGREEMENT

1. Shenandoah University's School of Nursing will keep Blue Ridge Community and Technical College continually advised of any changes in pre-requisites or other requirements for transfer into the BSN program.
2. Shenandoah University's School of Nursing will keep Blue Ridge Community and Technical College continually advised of opportunities for prospective students, such as information sessions, etc.
3. This agreement will go into effect for those BRCTC students entering Shenandoah University's School of Nursing Fall 2015, and remain in effect until terminated by either party upon written notice to other party of an intention to terminate. Such notice will be effective only if given 180 days prior to the intended date of termination. In the event that this agreement is terminated, the terms of the agreement contained herein will remain in effect for a minimum of three years.

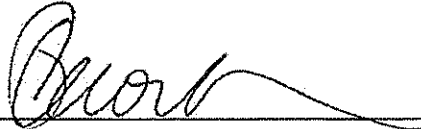
