BCT Bank of Charles Town Scholarship – High School Seniors

Applicants must be currently enrolled as a high school senior in Berkeley or Jefferson County, must enroll in at least 6 credit hours at Blue Ridge CTC in the fall semester upon high school graduation. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA or higher. Students must submit a copy of their current high school transcript, and a typed personal statement about college/career goals.

Blue Ridge CTC Foundation High School Excellence Scholarship - High School Seniors

The Foundation will provide one scholarship to one graduate from each high school in Berkeley, Jefferson, and Morgan Counties. This award is available only to high school seniors planning to enroll in at least 6 credit hours at Blue Ridge Community & Technical College. Applicant must be a West Virginia resident. Must have at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA. Students must submit a copy of their current high school transcript, a list of extracurricular activities, and a typed personal statement discussing college/career goals.

Blue Ridge CTC Foundation is providing a unique opportunity for one Tri-County high school student who has demonstrated an outstanding level of scholastic excellence to receive the Blue Ridge CTC Foundation Presidential Scholarship. The recipient of this award must meet the application requirements for the Blue Ridge CTC Foundation High School Excellence Scholarship as stated above AND must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5 to be eligible.

GED/EDP Scholarship Program

Eligible candidates must be West Virginia residents and have an EDP or GED graduating score of 250 prior to Jan. 1, '02 or a score of 2500 after Jan. 1, '02. Eligible candidates must write a short autobiography about themselves and their life prior to obtaining their GED, why they decided to work towards their GED, and other topics. RESA VIII

A scholarship program administered by the Regional Education Service Agency 8 (RESA 8) is offered annually to West Virginia GED graduates in the RESA 8 service area. Request an application if you are a GED graduate with a score of at least 2500 completed between July 1, 2008 and March 31, 2011.

Dr. Trudie Holder Scholarship Business

The Dr. Trudie Holder Scholarship was established by Blue Ridge faculty and staff from Blue Ridge CTC in honor of her retirement and her 27 years of dedicated service to the College and students. The award is for full-time non-traditional student in a business-related field of study who has: completed one year of college study; has a G.P.A. between 2.80 and 3.20. Preference is given to students not eligible for PELL Grants.

The Hollywood Casino Scholarship Business & Culinary

The Hollywood Casino Scholarship was established in 2012 by Hollywood Casino at Charles Town Races. Applicant must have a 3.0 grade point average or better, be in need of financial assistance, and be enrolled in a culinary or business related program.

Berkeley County Crime Solvers Scholarship Criminal Justice

The recipient is chosen by the Criminal Justice or Fire Science Department.

Ida Elizabeth Hendricks Scholarship Developmental Education

Mrs. Ida Elizabeth Hendricks served her students and the community as the Coordinator of Developmental Mathematics Education at both Shepherd University and Blue Ridge CTC. In honor of her long service and commitment, Mr. William Hendricks created a scholarship for developmental mathematics education during the spring semester of their application. Application requirements include grade selectivity, a letter of recommendation, and a personal essay.

C. Vincent Townsend EMS Scholarship

Dr. Townsend was the regional Medical Director of North Eastern Regional Emergency Medical Services for more than 20 years. Upon his retirement, members of the EMS community established this scholarship in his honor.

M. Douglass Harlan Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship is awarded by Blue Ridge CTC and is open to female two-year degree seeking students who have at least a 2.0 G.P.A. and are enrolled full-time. It is based on financial need and is renewable. A female Head of Household who exhibits financial need per FAFSA.

Martha Maxwell Developmental Education Scholarship

This scholarship is for students who complete at least two courses or participate in certain Developmental Program activities. Students are required to type a 500 word, double spaced essay. They are also required to provide a copy of their most recent college transcript, as well as letters of recommendation from the sponsoring NADE Chapter and from their school official, instructor or counselor. Students are also required to give a copy of their resume (1-3 pages) that will include specific information.

D. Lee Morgan Scholarship Fire Science

This scholarship was established in 2002 to honor D. Lee Morgan. He was a career firefighter in Shepherdstown, WV and helped develop the Fire Science Program. He served on Shepherd University's board of advisors and received the college's President's Medal Award in 1991. Awarded annually to students majoring in Fire Science, with a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5, by the Fire Science faculty and approved by the Financial Aid and Scholarship Committee.

Jefferson County CEOS Foundation Scholarship

This scholarship is being funded by the Jefferson County Community Educational Outreach Service Special Funds in an effort to give a US citizen of Jefferson County, West Virginia, financial help. The person's desire must be to better their abilities by increasing their education, working skills and employability within the Eastern Panhandle of West Virginia. This scholarship is open to United States citizens of Jefferson County, West Virginia who need financial help. This scholarship will be for first Health Related Courses and second Culinary Arts. The recipient will have a grade average of a B (3.0) but no lower than a 2.00 G.P.A. in the first semester. A completed application, transcript, signature form, and request letter will be required of each person selected.

NADE Award to Outstanding Alumnus of a Developmental Education Program

This award recognizes an alumnus of a Developmental Education Program who has distinguished himself/herself in an educational career and other areas of life. Student must complete two Developmental courses or participate in particular Developmental Programs. Developmental programs include: TRIO Upward Bound, TRIO Student Support Service, and High School-to-College BRIDGE Program. The student must also be a part of a Special Admission Program, show outstanding accomplishments outside the classroom in an educational or career setting, and enroll in Developmental classes (examples: math, reading, study skills, writing).

Child Development Scholarship

This program awards scholarships to child care workers in West Virginia. Eligible applicants must have successfully completed the U. S. Department of Labor's Apprenticeship for Child Development Specialist (ACDS) program or are in the fourth semester of the program, and must be enrolled, or accepted for enrollment, in an undergraduate degree program in early childhood education or specialization, in West Virginia. Information on the programs, course requirements, and costs is available from the Child Development Coordinator at Blue Ridge or you may contact the WV Higher Education Policy Commission for more information.
