To be admitted to the College of Business and Economics, students must have an overall GPA of 2.0. To be directly admitted to their desired major, students must also complete the following College of Business and Economics prerequisite courses with a minimum grade of C or better:

- CS 101 (WVU); ECON 205 & 206; MATH 105 & MATH 150 (WVU); ENGL 101 & 102: ACCT 201 & 202; and MATH 114

Students should select at least one SCIENCE Elective listed on the WV HEPC Core Coursework Transfer Agreement to successfully complete WVU's GEF 2B requirement.

Students are required to complete 3 credit hours (one course) from each of the GEF Areas 4 through 7 before successful graduation from West Virginia University. Students following the plan of study above will complete GEF Areas 4, 5, and 6 prior to graduation from BRCTC. GEF 7 will need to be completed at WVU.
