An unrestricted license to practice nursing and a grade point average of 2.5 or better on all college work attempted are required to be eligible for consideration.

(Students must successfully pass the National Council Licensure Examination-Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN) test prior to admittance to the RN-BSN program. Upon verification, 50 Undifferentiated Nursing credit hours are awarded based on RN licensure.)
