Studying Online

- Remaining credit hours needed are 30 general education (transferred or completed) plus 30 nursing.

RN to MSN

- Accelerated advanced degree and specialization for roles in leadership, case management, infection control, informatics or education.
- Active RN license required.

MSN

- Five Specializations: Management and Organizational Leadership, Case Management, Nursing Informatics, Infection Prevention & Control, and Nursing Education
- 12 course program.

DNP

- Doctor of Nursing Practice Executive Leadership - designed to foster the advanced practice of nursing leadership
- Doctor of Nursing Practice Educational Leadership - further develops leadership skills for nursing education leaders
- Two-year program.
