There will be one more performance, as the final event of this year's Book Faire, on Sat, April 26th, at 7:30, in the Martinsburg High Auditorium.

The play has been cast (25 parts), 95% from the BR student body, but also from alumni, faculty, staff, and community members. Add 10 crew and tech booth positions, 35 us are now in full rehearsal to bring the Pulitzer Prize winning play (often called America's play) alive. Please attend, if you can. Price at the door is two dollars for students (students from any school), seven dollars for adults. Children under 12 will be admitted free.

HEALTH INSURANCE WORKSHOP

Dear Students:

Do you need health insurance? Are you concerned about affordability? This is your chance to learn more and possibly enroll at a fraction of what you may anticipate. The health insurance marketplace is open by federal law enacted by Congress. The ACA provides for the following:

- * The ability to join a parent's plan until age 26
- * Tax credits to help pay for health insurance
- * Improved student health insurance plans
- * Catastrophic plans that provide emergency coverage at a lower upfront cost

In addition, no one will be turned away for having a preexisting condition.

Blue Ridge CTC will host a health insurance workshop on March 26th at the main campus to provide information and assistance regarding the new insurance marketplace. The information session will be at 5p with enrollment sessions in computer labs at 5p, 6p, 7p and 8p. Trained representatives known as navigators will be on hand to help guide you, eligible family members and the community at large, providing essential information on the application and enrollment process. This effort is focused on connecting our students, families and community with the right resources and information to allow for the selection of the optimal health insurance plan.

The information session and enrollment sessions are free and open to the public, but space is limited. Hurry, as the enrollment deadline is March 31st – this is the government's "last call." <u>Criteria</u>

Eligible applicants must

- Be a full-time Blue Ridge Community & Technical College student
- Be enrolled in at least one of the following mathematics course: ACFN 065, ACFN 085, MATH 100, or MATH 100A in Summer or Fall 2014
- Have a 2.5 cumulative GPA or 2.5 GPA at midterm for first semester students.
- Have earned a "C" or higher in any previously completed developmental mathematics course work, if applicable, and have a passing average in any current developmental mathematics coursework.

Procedure

- Type a short essay answering the following questions:
 - 1. Why are you attending college?
 - 2. What are your academic/career goals?
 - 3. How will this scholarship help you to achieve your goals?
- Submit a copy of your previous semester final grades as well as your current semester midterm grades.
- Submit a letter of recommendation from any full-time or part-time employee of Blue Ridge Community and Technical College (excluding mathematics instructors).
