# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT LEADING TO A B.S. IN NURSING BETWEEN FAIRMONT STATE UNIVERSITY AND BLUE RIDGE COMMUNITY AND TECHNICAL COLLEGE

Fairmont State University and Blue Ridge Community and Technical College, in order to promote the transfer of students between the two institutions seeking degrees in Nursing and thereby increase educational opportunities for students in West Virginia, establish this articulated program leading to the B.S. degree in Nursing to be granted by Fairmont State University. Upon satisfactory completion of the Associate of Science degree in Nursing at Blue Ridge Community and Technical College and after fulfillment of Fairmont State University admission and course placement requirements, students may transfer into the BSN Program at Fairmont State University.

Fairmont State University and Blue Ridge Community and Technical College agree to monitor and support the provisions of this agreement to ensure consistency, program quality, and transferability for the benefit of the students of both institutions. Fairmont State University and Blue Ridge Community and Technical College agree to coordinate changes in the course content or requirements for any courses listed in the articulation agreement in order to ensure continued comparability between the courses offered on each campus. Fairmont State University and Blue Ridge Community and Technical College agree to renegotiate this agreement as necessary due to changes in curriculum or graduation requirements implemented by either institution. This process will be the responsibility of the appropriate deans at both institutions.

Students pursuing the B.S. in Nursing through the articulation agreement will be bound by the curriculum sheets in effect at the time they are officially accepted into the articulated program. The attached curriculum sheets dated January 22, 2018, will be in effect until officially changed and agreed upon by both institutions. It is important to note that Blue Ridge Community and Technical College graduates would be required to meet all Fairmont State University and BSN Program graduation requirements.

- Students would need enough free electives to obtain the 120 total hours to graduate.
- Developmental courses cannot be counted toward graduation credits.
- Requests for general studies exceptions should be directed to the FSU Registrar.
- · Request for statistics or management course acceptance should be directed to the nursing department.
- Students can be admitted to the BSN Program without an active nursing license, but they must be licensed in order to take NURS 3350 or higher.
- All credits toward graduation must be completed prior to or concurrently with NURS 4440 Nursing Practicum.
- Students may take transferrable and approved general studies courses in their associate degree program.
- Students that have taken all or most of their general studies courses may be able to accelerate through the BSN coursework.
