- Complete any courses in reading, writing, or math within the first year*
- Meet regularly with your advisor, career specialist, and tutors, and attend required enrichment activities

- Have you applied or been accepted to BRCTC and are majoring in an Ascend eligible program listed below?
- Are you a West Virginia resident or resident in our Metro Servicing Area?
- Do you agree to maintaining good academic standing and full-time enrollment in an Ascend approved major listed below?
- If you are a continuing or transfer student, do you have no more than 15 college credits and a minimum GPA of 2.0?
