ABOUT JUMPSTART

Blue Ridge Community and Technical College and Jefferson County Schools have partnered to provide a dual enrollment option for high school Seniors to begin the college experience while in high school. With discounted college tuition, along with ease of scheduling, high school students have the option to get a "jumpstart" on college coursework.

WHY ENROLL?

Save Time

These programs allow Seniors to take advantage of earning both college and high school credit. Enter college with credits that may reduce time earning your degree.

Enrolling in the JumpStart program saves considerable time and money. At the current rate of \$25 per credit hour*, students save \$147/per credit hour**.

COMPLETING COURSEWORK

Jefferson County Schools provides transportation to high school Seniors to travel from the home high school to the Blue Ridge CTC Main Campus. Courses are held from 11:20am to 1:45pm, the equivalent of 4th through 7th periods. Students complete 8 courses, earning credit to be used toward general education requirements for programs at Blue Ridge CTC.

TRANSFERABILITY

Many of the courses included in the General Studies JumpStart Program are part of the WV CORE Transfer agreement, allowing students to potentially receive credit for courses at West Virginia public institutions. Students who intend to transfer to another institution must be aware of the specific program requirements at the receiving institution. Students should contact the receiving institution to ask about transferability of coursework. The College also has a number of transfer agreements already in place and available for review on the Blue Ridge website.

GENERAL STUDIES JUMPSTART PROGRAM

The General Studies program offers students the foundation for a wide variety of majors at Blue Ridge CTC allowing students to direct their studies toward a career and program of study of their choosing.
