CLASS OF DECEMBER 2020


The graduating class of December 2020 was constructed of 243 students earning a total of 287 degrees and certificates. From 243 students, 90% responded to the graduate survey. Of the December 2020 graduates, 62% of students have selected to continue their education and 27.5% are currently employed. 




