
The graduating class of August 2021 was constructed of 55 students earning a total of 64 degrees and certificates. From 55 students, 69% responded to the graduate survey. Of the August 2020 graduates, 53% of students have selected to continue their education and 16% are currently employed. Students who are actively searching for employment are continuously working with the Office of Career Services to find placement within the workforce.


