Wondering How to Apply?

The Blue Ridge CTC pre-nursing major is the Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Medical Assisting – Nursing Foundation. All students who wish to change majors to nursing should select this major and concentration prior to applying to the Nursing Program. If already awarded a Medical Assisting degree, students should choose the Healthcare Professions degree. If accepted into the Nursing Program, your major will change to the Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN) upon admission.

Second Start/Second Half Term: Prerequisites that fall under the Second Start or Second half term will not be considered if taken in the same semester the student is applying for entrance into the nursing program.

Transferring from another school? BRCTC does not accept any nursing credits from another nursing program.

Traditional Nursing Program Admission Requirements

- Be a current, active Blue Ridge CTC student.
If transferring in credit from another institution, ensure transfer evaluation process is complete prior to the application deadline.
- Complete or be enrolled in the following courses:
ENGL 101; MATH 114 OR MATH 101; and BIOL 120/121
> By the Spring Semester (for Summer/Fall applicants)
> By the Fall Semester (for Spring applicants)
Any science courses taken more than five years prior to the ASN program start date are not counted as part of the application
- Earn a “C” or higher in all required courses for the program. *For decision-making regarding application scoring criteria only, midterm grades will be used for all required courses in which the student is currently enrolled. However, final grades must still meet the minimum requirements*
- Earn an overall GPA of 2.5 (includes transfer courses)
- Earn at least a 63.3 composite score on the ATI TEAS test PRIOR to submitting application
- Submit completed ASN Application by the deadline

Accelerated Nursing Program Requirements

Special Requirements (Summer admission only)

- Earn an overall GPA of 3.0 (includes transfer courses)
- Earn at least a 70.0 composite score on the ATI TEAS test PRIOR to submitting application
- Preference will be given to students who have completed corequisite ASN courses and do not work full-time

To prepare for the TEAS, it is recommended students:

- Complete BRCTC’s English and Math Bootcamps.
