Job Summary

The Automotive Technician performs all aspects of new vehicle conversion to include (but not limited to) installation of emergency warning devices, electronics, custom fabricated items such as consoles and cabinetry, wire harnesses and more.

Responsibilities & Duties

- Perform tactical skills such as fabrication, vehicle automotive wiring and technical troubleshooting as it pertains to all aspects of vehicle production. Such task offered for example but not limited to cutting body sides for lighting, fabricating, and running harnesses under vehicle, molding and shaping items for custom fit, painting and commercial coatings, installation of external accessories, wiring and hookup of electrical items, detailing and cleaning of vehicle, testing and troubleshooting vehicle performance, support and maintenance.
