

# PURSUE AN ASSOCIATE DEGREE WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL

Students in the Dual Enrollment program receive both high school and college credit. High School students who enroll at Blue Ridge CTC receive a special tuition rate, allowing them to save both time and money while investing in their college education.

Blue Ridge CTC offers approximately 100 transfer agreements to ensure ease of transfer to a four year school. Plus, the State-wide Transfer Education Program provides a prescriptive list of classes guaranteed to transfer to an in-state, public college or university! Students who plan to attend a private or out-of-state school must contact the transfer institution to confirm transferability of credit.

Working with Blue Ridge CTC's High School Enrollment Specialist allows students to design a custom schedule to meet their needs and future goals.



## HOW TO ENROLL

1. Fill out High School Student application
2. Homeschool students must contact the contact local Board of Education to obtain **Homeschool Enrollment Verification Letter**
3. Complete required ACT, SAT, or **free** placement test. Test scores are required for English, Math and Chemistry courses.
