


Welcome to the Graduate Report! The Office of Career Services is excited to share the results of the May 2022 Graduate Survey.


The graduating class of May 2022 was constructed of 267 students earning a total of 642 degrees and certificates. From 267 students, 67% responded to the graduate survey. Of the May 2022 graduates, 43% of students have selected to continue their education and 14% are currently employed. Students who are actively searching for employment are continuously working with the Office of Career Services to find placement within the workforce.




