PARENT/STUDENT CAREER PLANNING DINNER

Parents and students join Blue Ridge CTC Staff to discuss no-cost college enrollment options available to students. Parents tour the Veterinary Technician facilities and learn more about outcomes achieved during summer programming.

INSTRUCTOR-LED INTERNSHIPS

Students spend several afternoons visiting and working at local shelters under the guidance of an instructor. Students document volunteer hours and can use these for application requirements to enter future programs.

MORGAN COUNTY SCHOLARS

Morgan County High School Seniors can take advantage of the Morgan County Scholars Program. The Morgan County Scholars program provides general education courses at no-cost to students. These courses provide extra points on the application into the Blue Ridge CTC Veterinary Technician program. Students should work with their School Counselor to enroll in the Morgan County Scholars program.
