



JOB DESCRIPTION

Position: Field Services / Environmental Technician

Company: A-Zone Environmental Services, LLC, an environmental consulting and field services firm, is seeking a Field Services/Environmental Technician to join our growing team. The position is located in Charles Town.

Job Description: The position involves support of our environmental drilling and field services operations. Job responsibilities will include assisting lead environmental driller, maintenance of small and heavy equipment, collection of various environmental samples. Position requires up to 30% overnight travel. Occasional use of respirators, protective suits, and other personal protective equipment may be required.

Job Duties:

- Assist lead driller with environmental drilling and sampling operations.
- Operate and perform general maintenance on small and heavy equipment.
- Maintain equipment in a clean, lubricated, painted, and good working condition.
- Oversee delivery and off-loading of supplies and materials.
- Safely delivery equipment and materials to jobsites.
- Complete field reports.
- Operate equipment and perform work safely.

Required knowledge, skills, and abilities:

Must be able to work and think independently. Must have a familiarity with operation and maintenance of small and heavy equipment. Must possess excellent written and oral communication skills and must work well with other staff and clients.

Education and Experience:

High School Diploma, GED, or vocational school. Supplemental education by college or technical training courses in environmental science or a related field would be preferred.

Certificates, Licenses, and Registrations:

A valid driver's license is required and a safe driving record as measured by company policy. A CDL would be preferred. Also preferred is 40-hour HAZWOPER certificate and current 8-hour refresher. Employment is dependent upon the findings of a background check.

Physical Requirements: Work may be performed under extreme weather conditions including hot and cold ambient temperatures. Tasks involve bending, lifting, walking, carrying and using a force equal to lifting 50 to 100 pounds. Employment is dependent upon passing drug screening and physical examination by medical professional for the anticipated work requirements.

Salary: This is an hourly position with overtime. Typical work schedule is between 30 and 50 hours per week. Pay is dependent upon qualifications and experience.
